In NSW & ACT the STA is NSW - State Training Services (STS) and ACT -Training and Tertiary Education (TaTE)

Registered Training Organisation (RTO)

Develops a training plan and delivers the training



RTOs deliver workplace or offsite training arrangements, help develop a training plan, deliver training, assess achievement of skills and issue the qualification on successful completion.
